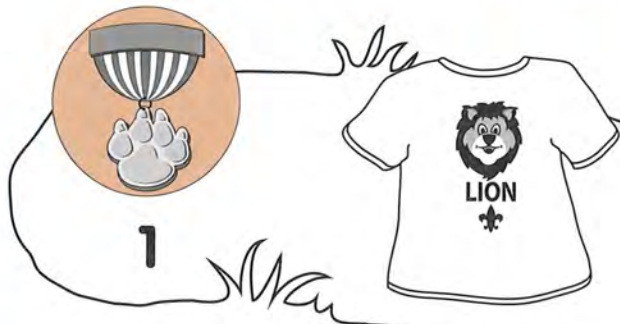

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LION'S HONOR



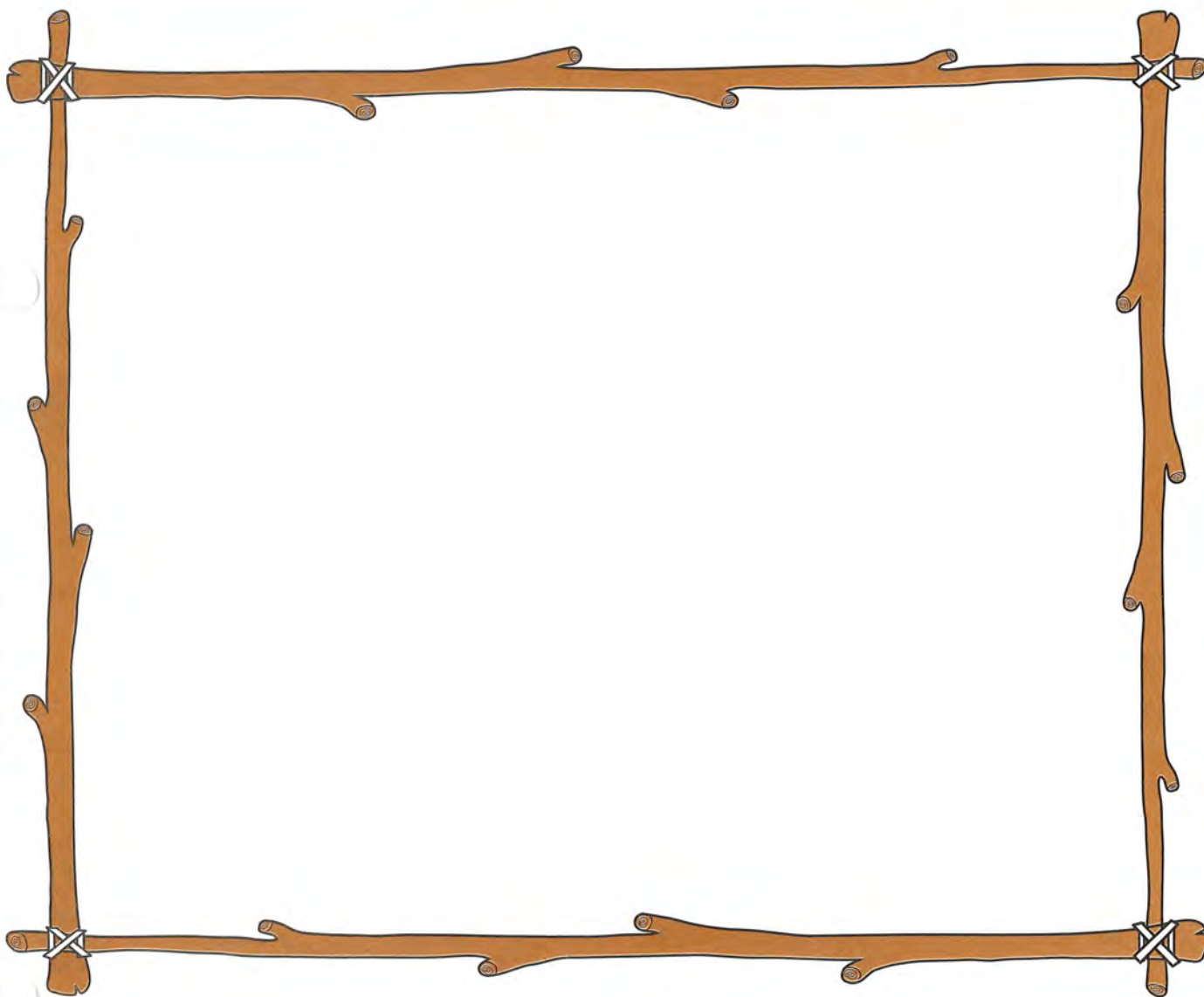
Cub Scouts have their own special sign.

Now that you have built a tower, think of one way you can build up a Lion friend with kind words.

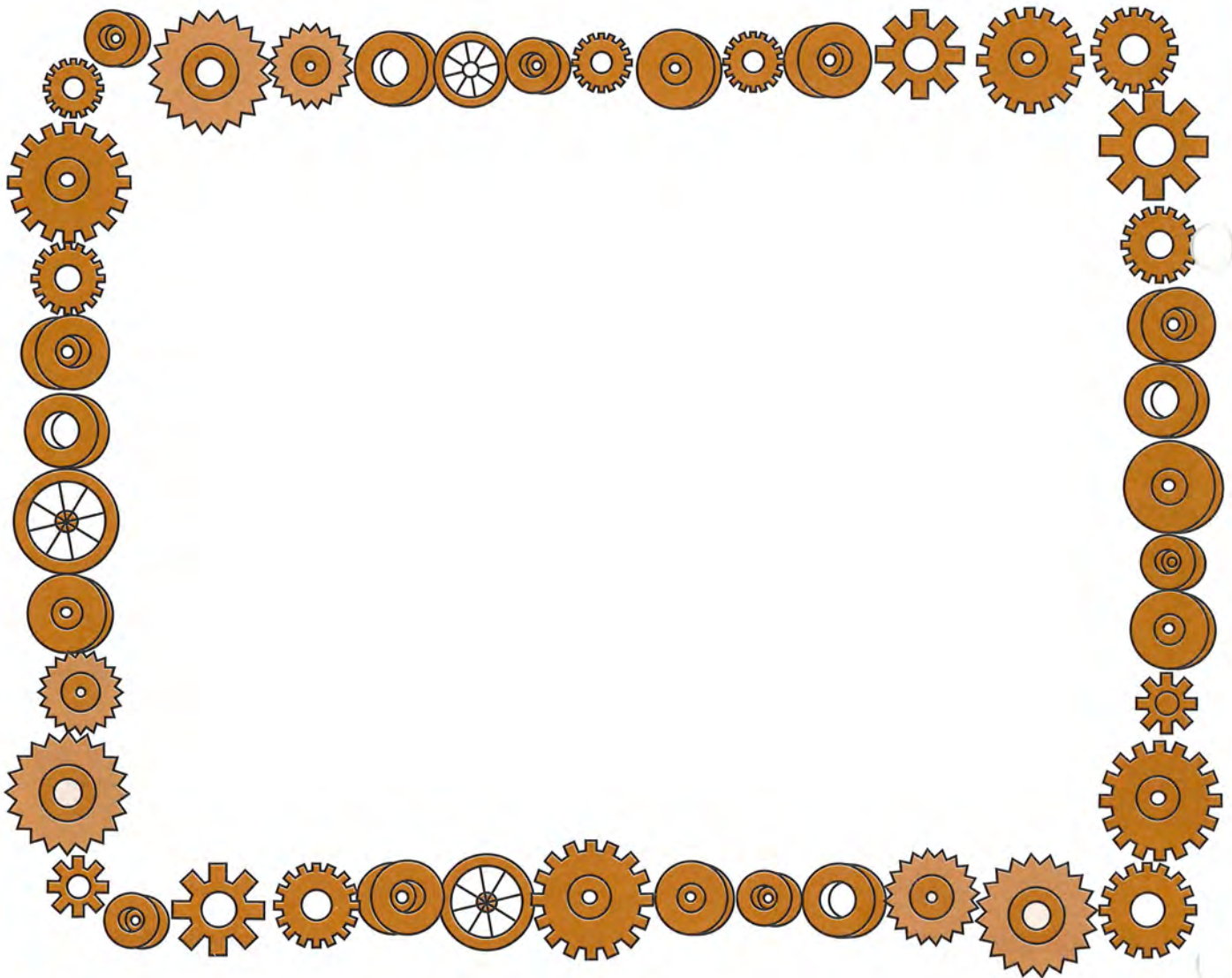




GIZMOS AND GADGETS

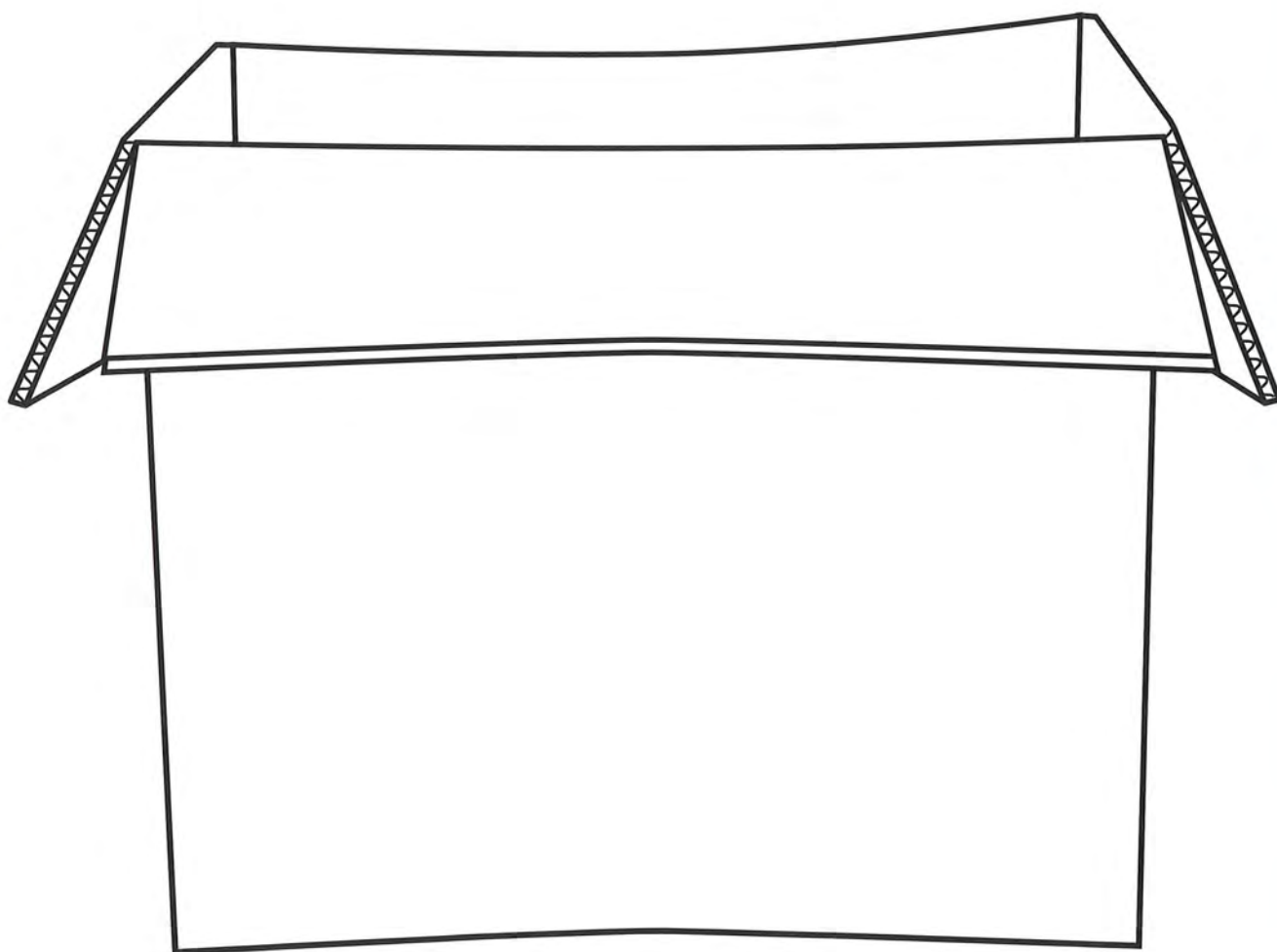




ON YOUR MARK

Can you decorate it to look like a race car?





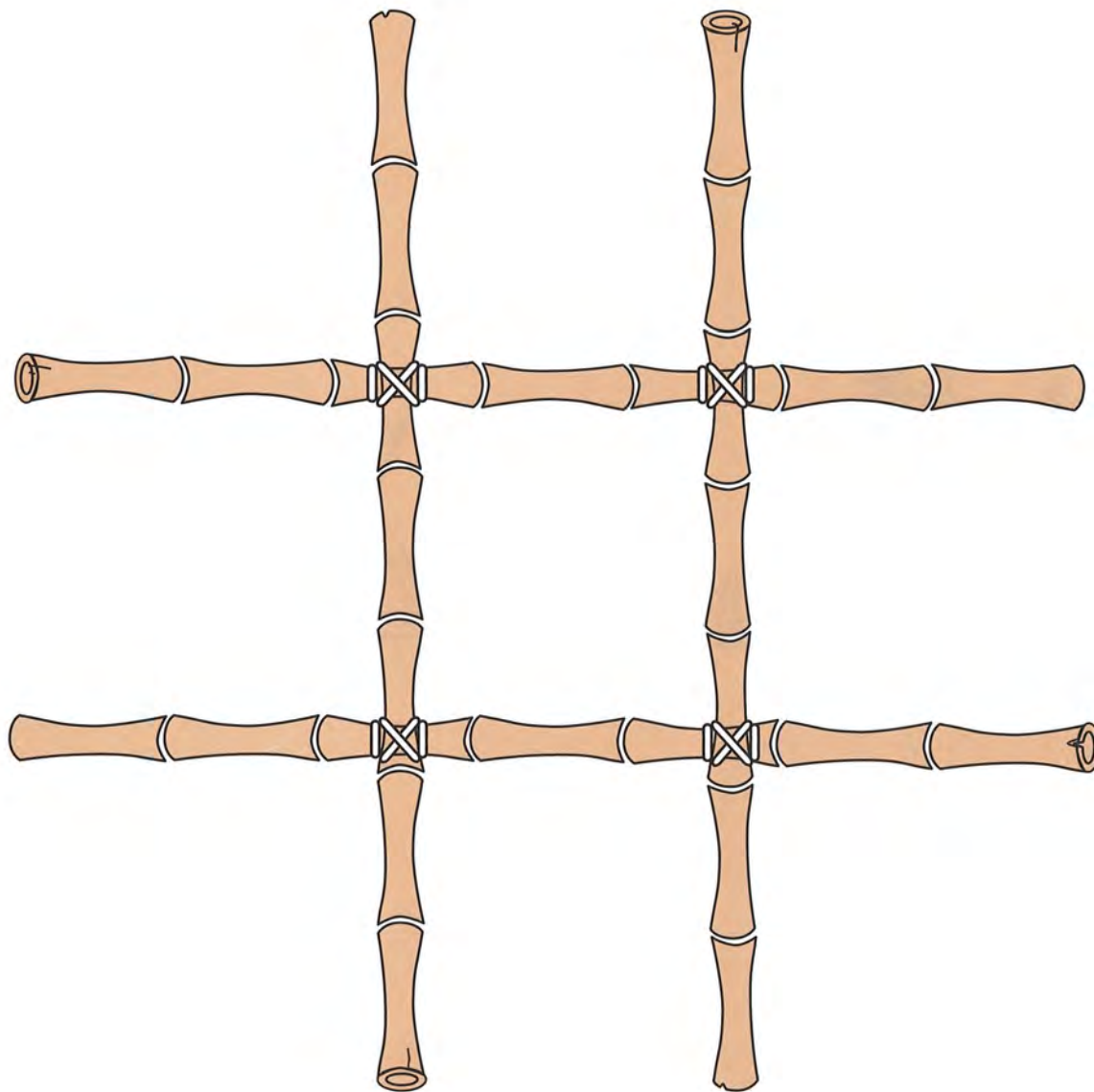
PICK MY PATH

Use the paws as game pieces. Then find a friend and play.

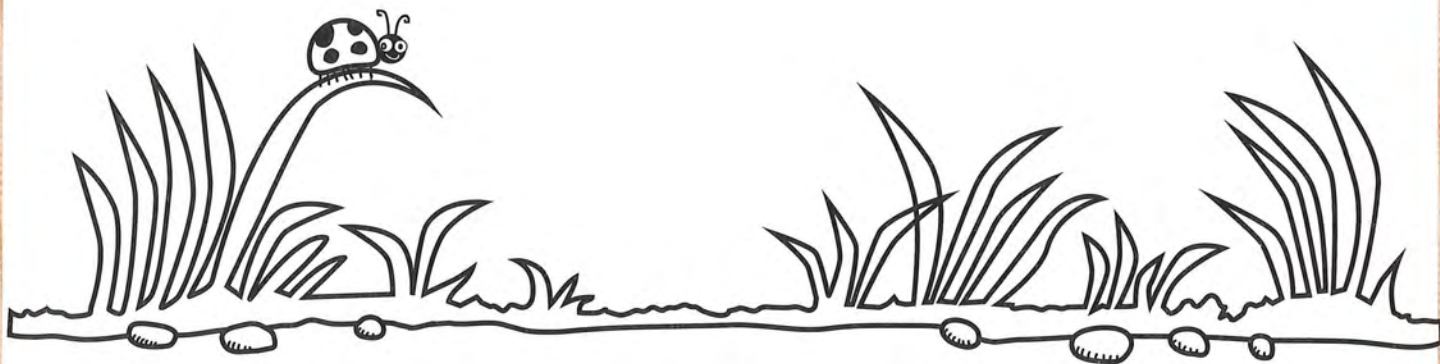

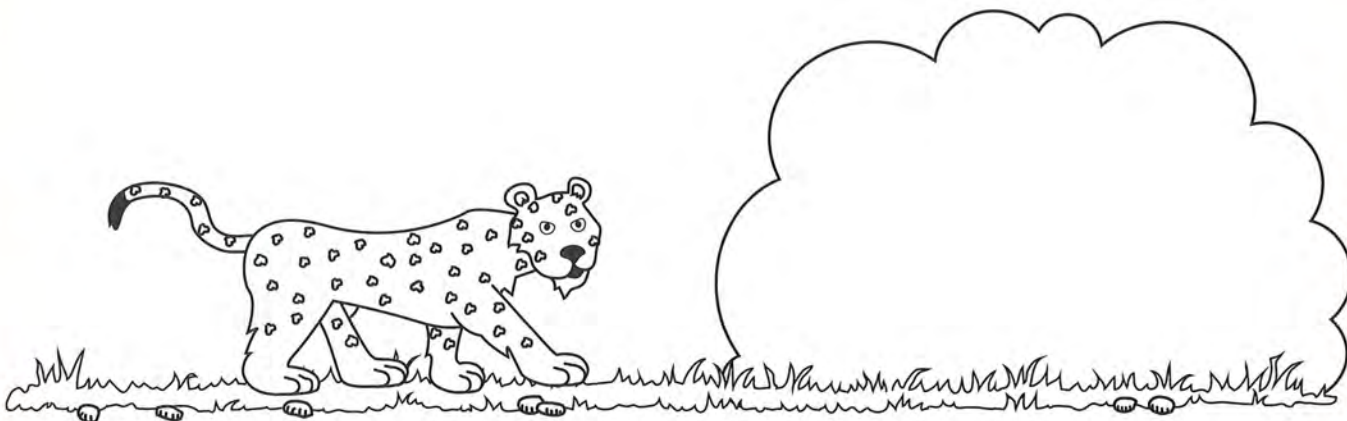
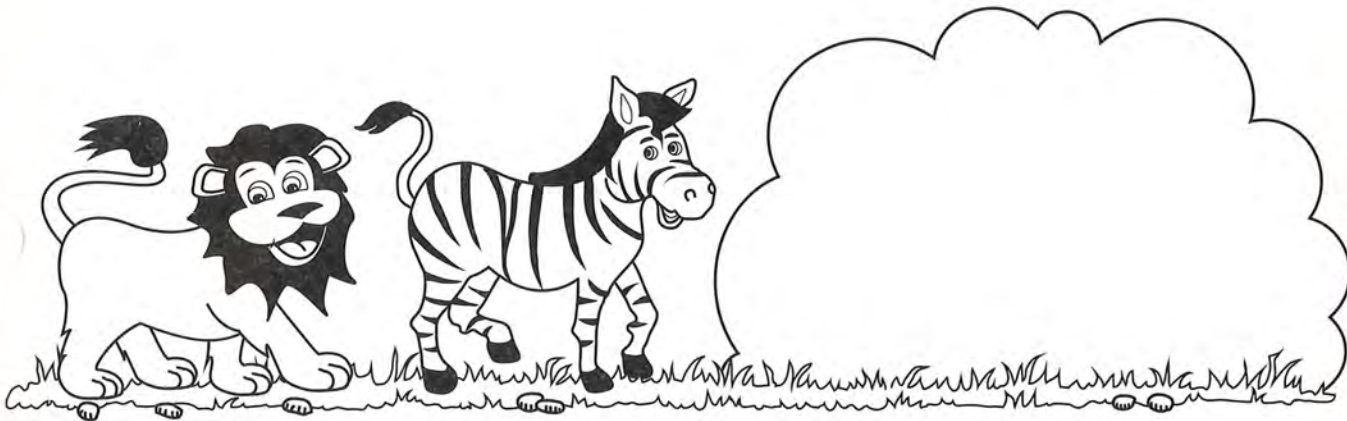




RUMBLE IN THE JUNGLE
